Guidelines for the Elementary Class

These steps and formations **make up the criteria** for people who have been through a Beginners' programme. The dancers should already have had some experience of the music, skipping, Skip-Change and a few simple formations - see the Beginners' Guidelines.

They are now ready to begin learning the formations and steps listed below:-

Aspects of dancing also need to be paid attention to:-

Footwork - positions Transitions between one step/formation and another Hands - shake hands, men and ladies presentation, for turning Phrasing - fitting the steps to the musical phrases and the formations
