To find Amisfield School in Tokoroa:

From the South: As you enter the 80kph area on State Highway One, take the first turn to your right onto Moffat Road.

From the North: Travel along S.H.1 past the CBD and after you reach the 80kph zone take the first turn to the left. This is just before the 100kph area.

Once you are on Moffat Road the school entrance is the first driveway on the right.

Paisley Origins

4 x 32 bar Jig

- 1 - 8 1st couple lead down the middle to below 4th couple, casting up behind their own lines to original places
- 9 - 16 1st couple cross over giving right hands, cast behind 2nd couple who step up on bars 11 & 12; cross over giving left hands, cast behind 3rd & 4th couples who step up on bars 15 & 16
- 17 - 24 1st couple dance a figure of eight around 4th couple, crossing up to begin WHILE 3rd couple dance a figure of eight around 2nd couple, crossing up to begin
- 25 - 28 All four couples advance and retire
- 29 - 32 All four couples turn with the right hand with 2nd couple retaining hands and facing down at the end of bar 32 as the 3rd, 4th & 1st couples return to the sidelines.
In the last repeat all 4 couples finish on the sidelines.

Repeat with a new top couple
